## **ORDINANCE 1380**

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE TWO-MILE ETRA TERRITORIAL ZONING JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF SENECA, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was duly held and the Seneca Planning Commission recommends the following amendment to the zoning regulations of the city of Seneca, Kansas.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SENECA, KANSAS:

Section 1: The following described property shall be zoned TA-1 Transitional Agricultural District within the two-mile extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction of the city of Seneca, Kansas:

A tract of land in the NW/q of the NW/q of Sect. 27, Township 2, Range 12, in Nemaha County, Kansas. Beginning at the NW/c of said Sect. 27, and running thence East of the Section line 478.5', thence South 1 degree 13 minutes, East 364.13', thence North 88 degrees 47 minutes West 478.5' to a point on the West Section line of said Sect. 27, and running thence North on said Section line 364.13' to the POB. Said tract contains 4 acres, more or less.

Property is commonly known as 2013 North 11th Street.

**Section 2:** EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective after publication in the city newspaper.
